AUTISM TRAINING

Ensuring that flapping will be considered as acceptable as smiling, ear defenders will be a normal sight, Alternative communication devices will be common and everyone will know how to communicate with each other. SUCCESS STORY

Our training has been implemented across Pan Dorset which is combination of Dorset Council, Bournemouth Christchurch and Poole council and NHS services. Within 8 months, 800 of their workforce have completed our e-learning in Understanding Autism and over 150 have attended out Autism Acceptance workshops. They have left feeling enthusiastic and with the knowledge to make a change to the support the autistic individuals they support.

They have been able to introduce different communications techniques, adapt the environment from a sensory perspective and review processes to ensure that the autistic individuals they support can learn new skills, be given new opportunities and achieve their own personal aspirations.
