

Stour Summer 1 Learning overview



Writing:

- Practising letter formations, overwriting lines, shapes and letters, copying letters and words.

- Practising spelling their red words.

- Writing factual sentences about people who help us.

- Using symbols to build descriptive sentences.



Stour Class

Mathematics:

This half term Stour class will be looking at money. They will be exploring, matching, identify and sorting different coins. Some students may begin counting amounts using 2p's, 5p's and 10p coins. We will also be using money in our role play area and messy play, where the children will have the opportunity to explore the play shop and exploring sensory bags.







Preparation for Adulthood:

- Cooking food linking to the topic 'my world'

- PECS practise to support independent commenting and requesting.

- Cutlery practise to support independent eating.

- Trips to local parks to support transitions to new places, when in the community.

- Fun with food sessions to increase exposure to new foods.



Reading:

- RWI sessions to support both reading and verbalisations of the phonic sounds.

- Daily 1:1 reading.

- Answering a range of comprehension questions, working on the blank levels.

- Weekly yoga sessions with sensory stories.

Communication, Language and Literacy

- Reading information/factual texts
- Using PECS and symbols to request and comment linked to story
- Identifying 'People who help us' and their tools
- Hand writing, pre-writing patterns and mark making linked to people who help us
- Attention Autism stages 1-3



Mathematical Development:

- Matching and counting different coins
- Sorting according to colour and size
- Number songs
- Linking numerals to quantities





Preparation for Adulthood (inc Personal, Social and Emotional Development):

- Building independence with toileting and dressing
- Cooking linked to 'People who help us' topic
- Developing joint attention through Attention Autism
- Educational visits/ trips



Physical Development:

- Riding therapy
- Gross motor skills: climbing, bouncing, bikes, trikes and scooters
- Completing outdoor obstacle courses
- Fine motor skills: threading, playdough, cutting skills, pencil control
